

CAR PARK REGULATIONS, GENERAL PARKING CONDITIONS AND PARK PRIVACY INFORMATION

CAR PARK REGULATIONS

Art. 1

1.1 Use during events with free parking

The parking area is accessible free of charge and freely, without prejudice to the provisions of Articles 5, 6, 7 of these Car Park Regulations and letters A, B, C, D, E of the General Parking Conditions.

1.2 Use during events with paid parking

The parking area is accessible only after:

- a) the entry ticket has been collected or
- b) the QR code on the Car Parking Pass has been scanned upon entry or
- c) the license plate pre-associated with the Car Parking Pass has been recognised or
- d) the license plate of UnipolMove customers has been recognised or
- e) the Telepass device on board has been detected upon entry

Art. 2

The entry ticket referred to in point 1.2 a) can be collected at the car park entrance.

Art. 3

During events with free parking, the vehicle may freely exit the parking area, while **during events with paid parking**, the vehicle may only exit the parking area after payment has been made, as provided for in Art. 4.

Art. 4

Payment must be made:

A) before the vehicle leaves the parking area and can be made:

- at the car park checkouts - automatic or manned - of the Exhibition Centre or
- via Smartphone or
- automatically via Telepass device or
- automatically via the UnipolMove license plate-based service.

B) at the time of pre-purchasing, where applicable, the parking area in the Visitor Reserved Area or through other channels and within the terms provided therein, with electronic payment.

Exit must take place no later than the end of the day; after this deadline, the user must

pay an additional amount.

Art. 5

The parking title purchased for access to the car park is in no case refundable.

This no-refund policy applies to any purchase method, whether purchased **on-site** or **online**.

Art. 6

It is forbidden to introduce vehicles carrying flammable or otherwise hazardous materials or substances.

Art. 7

Vehicles parked outside the designated spaces will be removed at the user's cost and risk.

Art. 8

The Owner/Manager of the car park is not responsible for the custody of the vehicle, as they only provide access to the parking area and the availability of spaces in order to meet the needs of the public.

The Manager is therefore not responsible for any theft, damage, fire, tampering, acts of vandalism, natural disasters and/or actions of any kind or nature occurring and/or carried out on the vehicle.

GENERAL PARKING CONDITIONS

- A. Vehicle parking is the responsibility of the USER, who will be liable for any damage they may cause to people, vehicles and property present in the car park.
- B. Users are advised to leave their vehicles properly locked with the windows closed.
- C. The Owner/Manager of the car park is not liable for damage to or theft of vehicles or their contents, as specified in the Car Park Regulations and in these GENERAL PARKING CONDITIONS. No custody service is provided by the Owner/Manager of the car park.
- D. If the no-custody condition is not accepted, the user is authorised to leave the car park without delay and without any payment.
- E. Overnight parking is not permitted.
- F. In the event of loss of the entry ticket or deterioration thereof making it illegible, the user may pay for parking at the car park checkouts using the vehicle's license plate.

- G. A request for an invoice for parking purchased on-site must be made at the time of payment at the manned car park checkouts. A request for an invoice for parking purchased online must be made by completing the form received by e-mail after purchase.

The rates for parking areas that can be purchased on-site are available on the "PARK AT THE FAIR" page of the Event website.

The rate for pre-purchasable car parking, where applicable, is available in the Visitor Reserved Area, in the section dedicated to parking purchase.

PARK PRIVACY INFORMATION

Privacy Information - for the processing of personal data carried out through automatic number plate reading system - pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR")

Near the access gates to the vehicular lanes in front of and at the entrances to the parking lots of **Italian Exhibition Group S.p.A.** (hereinafter, "**IEG**" or "**Holder**") - Rimini headquarters, are operating systems for reading the license plates of vehicles in and out of the aforementioned gates, through special devices.

All these systems are appropriately indicated by signs placed before their range of action.

Data Controller

Personal Data Processed

Video footage and/or images concerning: license plate number of vehicles entering or exiting the access gates.

Purpose and legal basis of processing and retention period

The systems described above are installed for the **following purposes**:

- Access management and verification, through the vehicle license plate reading system, for employees/visitors/exhibitors/suppliers of IEG;
- Access management and verification of users with "car pass";
- Management of administrative obligations relating to parking payment;
- Management of technical and/or logistical issues.

Legal basis

The legal bases that make the processing lawful are:

- Fulfillment of legal obligations regarding the verification and management of access to the areas described above and for the purposes mentioned above.

Retention period

Italian Exhibition Group SpA, as Data Controller, retains the license plate reading images for a period of 10 days, starting from the moment the images were taken, except for the UnipolMove service, for which Italian Exhibition Group SpA, as Data Processor, will retain the license plate reading images, from the moment the vehicle leaves the parking lot and for a period of 100 days following the last calendar day of the month in which the parking was carried out.

After the aforementioned retention periods, the images are subject to automatic deletion, through an overwriting system. In any case, special needs for further conservation are reserved, determined by, for example: episodes having criminal relevance; specific investigative requests from the Judicial Authority.

Subjects authorized to process

The data may be processed by the personnel and operators of IEG's external supplier companies, deputed to the pursuit of the above purposes, who have been expressly authorized to process the data by appointment provided by the Data Controller, and have received due operating instructions and are bound by professional secrecy.

Data recipients

The data can be communicated at the request of the Judicial Authority and/or Public Security.

The data may be communicated to the UnipolTech Partner as the supplier of the UnipolMove electronic toll collection service based on the reading of the license plate of the vehicles.

The data may also be processed, on behalf of the Data Controller, by subjects designated as Data Processors pursuant to art.28 of the GDPR

Transfer of data abroad

Data are not transferred abroad.
